Our Executive Committee takes pleasure in presenting Annual Report for the year ending 31st March 2018 along with Audited Annual Accounts for the year ended on that date. During the year under review, the following are our achievements.

PRAVAH - Initiative & Effort

[This institution emerged in the 1990s against the struggle against illiteracy prevalent in the society through a literacy campaign conducted in the country. Since literacy is the first rung of development, women were literate on a wide scale by linking with the literacy mission, raising awareness of literacy in city and village. This movement organized women and made them aware of the organizational power. Since this movement was led by **PRAVAH**, it was registered under the Firm and Society in 2005 to establish these groups as "**PRAVAH SAMUH SANGAM SANGH SOCIETY**".]

- Efforts made to empower women of self-help groups economically and socially are as follows.

1. Plantation program: -

PRAVAH have always been serious on environmental protection and water augmentation, so every year in rural areas, women have been undertaking large-scale tree planting programs in the courtyards of the fields. Women of self-help groups have been continuously encouraged to plant trees in coordination with social forestry department. Under the auspices of the **Times of India** of **July 2018**, the organization planted **15,000** fruit trees in the Manchal-Indore region.





Flat plate and Incense stick Production Centers: -

PRAVAH also operates the Flat plate and Incense stick production centers under providing employment opportunities to women. Employment of women has been provided in this center. And has been associated with livelihood programs. Indian women working in an incense factory to make agarbatti. They roll bamboo sticks with charcoal powder and adhesive. The sticks are then sun-dried before they are dipped into aromatic liquids. The incense will eventually make its way into homes, offices and temples all over the world. Agarbatti are an integral part of any Hindu ritual. During rituals, an incense stick is lighted to remove unpleasant odors in the air. It creates the perfect setting for an auspicious ritual by filling the air with a pleasant smell. As they release smoke, they also act as organic disinfectants that drive away insects.



Stitch Embroidery Training Center: -

The **PRAVAH** keeps on continuously stitching embroidery training programs. Under this program, 1018 women have been trained and made employment oriented. Through the **PRAVAH**, the government schemes in collaboration with handloom department, national bank and public representatives have made them self-sufficient by getting sewing machines. This effort continues. Embroidery is the craft of decorating fabric or other materials using a needle to apply thread or yarn.



Embroidery may also incorporate other materials such as pearls, beads, quills, and sequins. In modern days, embroidery is usually seen on caps, hats, coats, blankets, dress shirts, denim, dresses, stockings, and golf shirts. Embroidery is available with a wide variety of thread or yarn color.

Some of the basic techniques or stitches of the earliest embroidery are chain stitch, buttonhole or blanket stitch, running stitch, satin stitch, cross stitch. Those stitches remain the fundamental techniques of hand embroidery today. The fabrics and yarns used in traditional embroidery vary from place to place. Wool, linen, and silk have been in use for thousands of years for both fabric and yarn. Today, embroidery thread is manufactured in cotton, rayon, and novelty yarns as well as in traditional wool, linen, and silk. Ribbon embroidery uses narrow ribbon in silk or silk/organza blend ribbon, most commonly to create floral motifs.



➤ **Research and evaluation: -**

PRAVAH has been an experienced institution in the field of research and evaluation. Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi, **N.H.D.C.** Bhopal, **N.M.D.C.** New Delhi, Ministry of Women and Child Development, New Delhi, has done many research and evaluation work under the aegis of National Work College on National Level related to World Vision of India and **UNICEF**, Which is based on the evaluation of literacy campaign, rehabilitation of displaced, child labor, dimensions of women empowerment, skill development in the market and employment opportunities etc.

ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMMES

HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The organization conducted the program in INDORE District of Madhya Pradesh State. Among the methods adopted, female sterilization predominates as 21.4 percent of the eligible women had unmet need is for spacing birth and the remains for limiting the children. A majority of the male respondents indicated progresses for female method. It was decided to prepare a wide AIDS scheme for the coverage of family planning Program by the society. Local doctors and Para-medical workers have extended their useful co-operation in diffusion of the requisite knowledge about family planes methods to the eligible couples with intrusive comparing in the district. More than 70% of India's population is living under the roof of rural setup. ... It aims to educate rural India and make them aware of how to take proper care of their health. This program is focused towards addressing issues of personal health care, vaccination, hygiene, and illness prevention. Think broadly about the factors that influence health. Considering the upstream factors that lead to longer, healthier lives can help identify root causes of your community's challenges.



WOMEN AWARENESS CAMP

The organization conducted the program in Indore District of Madhya Pradesh State. Our agents of social change. NGO, women's empowerment program is helping several thousand rural women add to their family income. NGO organizes rural women into micro-credit groups and provides them funds to build and manage a revolving development fund. These groups extend financial support to members, to set up small businesses, enabling them evolve into entrepreneurs. As if all the rights belonged to men even something as basic as voting. As the times evolved, women realized their power.



GENERAL AWARENESS CAMP

The organisation conducted the programme in Indore District of Madhya Pradesh State. This program is run on behalf of our organization, in which we spread awareness among the people of the society about general awareness such as education and our rights, in which we tell that the government in many ways to help the neglected people of the society. There is a need to be ready, so to know and understand it, in which we work fully on the ground star, the order makes every effort to make someone Do not be deprived of your rights due to information.



S.H.G. TRAINING PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Indore District of Madhya Pradesh State. The organization conducted the girls education program for the rural girls and women. Adolescent girls and matured girls are educated and trained by the organization to develop the business skills and production of commercial goods in their own home. Education especially for women is an important agent of socialization, and instrument of social transformation, and a channel of social mobility and equity. Education of girls and women has to be a universal movement for their empowerment, for changing current stereo-typed and replacing the existing structures.



CHILD & WOMEN NUTRITION PROGRAMME

SOCIETY started programme for women and children rights. In this programme our society organize meeting and seminars to intervene and give knowledge about women and children rights given by law. In this intervention & training programme about 50 youths benefited and trained organized by our society. Under this second stage meeting and seminars trained youths were teach uneducated women about law & rights. SOCIETY under this programme also teaches law & rights of child, specially focused on the topic of child labour. It was observed that in polio-vaccination day, Hepatitis-B etc. There was mass gathering on the day. As the people of rural area, have poor knowledge of legal rights and solution, the people should be attracted and according Legal-cum-Health Mela is being proposed to organise. The history of the respective programs, their beneficiaries, objectives, activities, organization, and evaluation are detailed. The ICDS beneficiaries are children below 6 years, pregnant and lactating mothers, and women aged 15-44 years, who are provided the following: supplementary nutrition; immunization; health check-ups; referral services; treatment of minor illnesses; pre-school education to children aged 3-6 years. The MDM program's intended beneficiaries are children attending the primary school.



SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) is the flagship scheme of the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE). The objective of this Skill Certification Scheme is to enable a large number of Indian youth to take up industry-relevant skill training that will help them in securing a better livelihood. To build capacity and ensure high quality skill development in infrastructure including construction sector to increase productivity of workers in this sector, through an emphasis on on-site training.

DRUG DE ADDICTION CAMP

On behalf of our organization, drivers, scholars and adolescents are made aware through a drug addiction program for the prevention of de-addiction in health camps, in this context, through regular meetings, it is expanded that the person of drinking . What is the adverse effect on the society and the family, due to this, from the experts of Health Department and Drug De-addiction Centers - What is an alcoholic substance, and how do their habits easily catch the youth of today, and how dangerous are its consequences and how to get rid of them? These things are made aware, and rehabilitation facilities are also provided to the youth who are addicted by the experts with our cooperation.
