## A BRIEF HILIGHTS ABOUT ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR 2021 -22

### ◆ Formation & Bank linkages of Self Help groups -

Bank linkage has been done to 234 self-help groups after completing the process of formation of 250 self-groups allotted under the aegis of NABARD, second linkage has also been done to 314 groups, and they are sponsored by **NABARD** for modern technology of mushroom production and goat rearing. Efforts are made to make them self-reliant by means of livelihood programs like modern technology.

- ◆ Under the National Urban Livelihood Mission (**NULM**), this year, allocations have been made for the formation of self-help groups, bank linkage and livelihood programs in the municipalities of the following districts, here are the details –

### A.L.F. – Area level Federation

- 240 SHG to be formed in three districts, in which **152** SHG have been formed, the process of formation of 13 **ALF** has been completed through these SHG.
- ◆ Training of food processing in coordination with **Mother Organization training health environment for rural sector**, *Dhar* has been provided to 315 beneficiaries.



▪ **Skill development training program –**

In coordination with **Jan Shikshan Sansthan Indore**, Bamboo Art 40, Traditional Handicraft, Embroidery 30, Stitching 20, Hand Rolled Agarbatti 40, General House Keeping 20, Home Cook 60, and Pickle Making Training-40 were given to women by PRAVAH.

- On 19 December 2021, under the aegis of **Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana** National Urban Livelihood Mission, an exhibition of materials produced by women and self-help groups was organized by PRAVAH at Maheshwar in *Khargone* district, 50 self-help groups of the district participated in this exhibition.

- **Rockledge teaching Pvt. Ltd.** Under the CSR project of the Municipal Corporation at the local level taken care of Tree plantation was done on a large scale in various wards of the Districts, this scheme is allotted for one year, in which about 2500 saplings are to be planted after completing five phases.

- The projects run under the aegis of NABARD were evaluated by the **NABARD** National Evaluation Representative and the results of the project were described as encouraging.

## ACTIVITIES PERFORMANCE OF THE YEAR 2021-22

### A. EXHIBITION OF CLOTHES PREPARED BY SHG MEMBERS (NABARD)

## B. HOME COOKING TRAINING -

In this campaign members of self help groups have been learned about cooking various types of dished at home, this skill also help them to get work, training have been provided by expert and experienced cook, and all trainees have been learned with full concentration and we have positive results.





## C. HAND ROLLED AGARBATTI MAKING TRAINING -

This year in skill development training to women – training of making hand rolled agarbatti is also a part of making self-dependent to the members of self help groups, in this training program by the experts there have been provided



proper training to beneficiaries in which whole process – to make powder mix of various types of fragrant materials and put them around sticks and after some time they have been prepared for use, there are many types of fragrance in agarbattis, their price is also different, so this skill also help them to make it their source of livelihood, after training our team also provide them support and guidance which is needed for start their own home based business.



## D. TRAINING & EXHIBITION OF HANDICRAFTS PRODUCTS -

[UNDER – “**Deendayal Antyodaya Yojna – National Urban Livelihood Mission**”]

Objective of this mission is to reduce urban and rural poverty by increasing livelihood opportunities through skill development and other measures. Keeping in view the objective of Make in India program, skill development is essential for social and economic betterment. Unemployment has been at its peak level for some time now. The lockdown continues across the country due to the Corona transition period. Of course jobs are being lost, but the situation is worse for the unemployed. This situation has happened both in the city and in the village. **Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana** is actually for the poor citizens of the country. Its beneficiaries include both urban and rural poor. In simple words, the goal of the central government is based on removing the poverty of the poor people of cities and villages through this scheme. For this, activities like organizing *Gramin Haat* have also been included. Along with this, considering the livelihood problems of urban street vendors, it is also necessary to provide suitable accommodation, institutional credit, social security, skills and other facilities to ensure their access to emerging market opportunities.





## E. Bamboo products making training -

Through this program experts provided training of making various products from bamboo like – baskets, pot shape products, and many types of furnitures this year, not only is bamboo products are much more eco-friendly than other similar materials, but it's also much more cost-effective to produce, making your goods much cheaper.

This year we celebrate international Women day with our team members, SHG group's members and girls all gathered at office of PRVAAH, the secretary of organization had been started the program by lighting a lamp and presented people discussed on issues related to women, made plan for further activities and made it a memorable day.
